

- SHOW YOUR STUDENTS YOU CARE ABOUT THEM.




RESULTS

REFLECTION

- YOU HAVE TO SHOW YOUR STUDENTS YOU CARE, BECAUSE THEY DO.
- YOUR STUDENTS WILL ALWAYS BELIEVE THAT WHAT YOU SAY IS TRUE, SO SAY GOOD THINGS!
- SOMETIMES YOUR STUDENTS DO NOT NEED YOU AS THEIR TEACHER, BUT AS THEIR FRIEND.
- TALK BEFORE YOU SCOLD.
- PAY ATTENTION TO YOUR STUDENTS' FRIENDS AND YOU CAN GET TO KNOW THEM A LITTLE BIT BETTER.

ENLIGHTENING - AS A PERSON

- I AM MORE PATIENT THAN I THOUGHT.
- I TREAT MY STUDENTS AS MY BEST FRIENDS.
- I HAVE NO PERSONAL PROBLEMS WHEN I AM IN THE CLASSROOM.
- I AM AWARE OF HOW TERRIBLE OUR SYSTEM EDUCATION IS.

INSPIRING - AS A TEACHER

- SCHOOL IS TOUGH FOR STUDENTS, SO DO NOT BE TOO STRICT, THEY ALREADY HAVE MATH.
- MOTIVATION IS MORE IMPORTANT THAN CLEVERNESS.
- TEACH YOUR CLASSES AS YOU WANT TO BE TAUGHT.
- ENJOY YOUR CLASSES, DO NOT TAKE ANYTHING PERSONAL, JUST IMAGINE YOU ARE PLAYING A VIDEOGAME.
- YOU NEED TO TALK TO YOUR STUDENTS IF YOU WANT TO UNDERSTAND THEIR BEHAVIOR.

REWARDING - AS A RESEARCHER

- YOU HAVE TO PAY ATTENTION TO DETAILS; YOUR STUDENTS' FRIENDS, NOTES, ATTITUDES, EXPRESSIONS, AND THE WAY THEY TALK, AMONG OTHERS.
- YOUR STUDENTS ARE WILLING TO TALK TO YOU, LET THEM KNOW THEY CAN.
- YOU CANNOT CHANGE REALITY IN ONE DAY, IT TAKES DISCIPLINE, PATIENCE AND PERSEVERANCE DAY BY DAY.
- THERE IS ALWAYS SOMETHING TO IMPROVE IN YOUR CLASSROOM.
- YOU ARE NOT THERE ONLY TO TEACH, BUT ALSO TO HELP.
